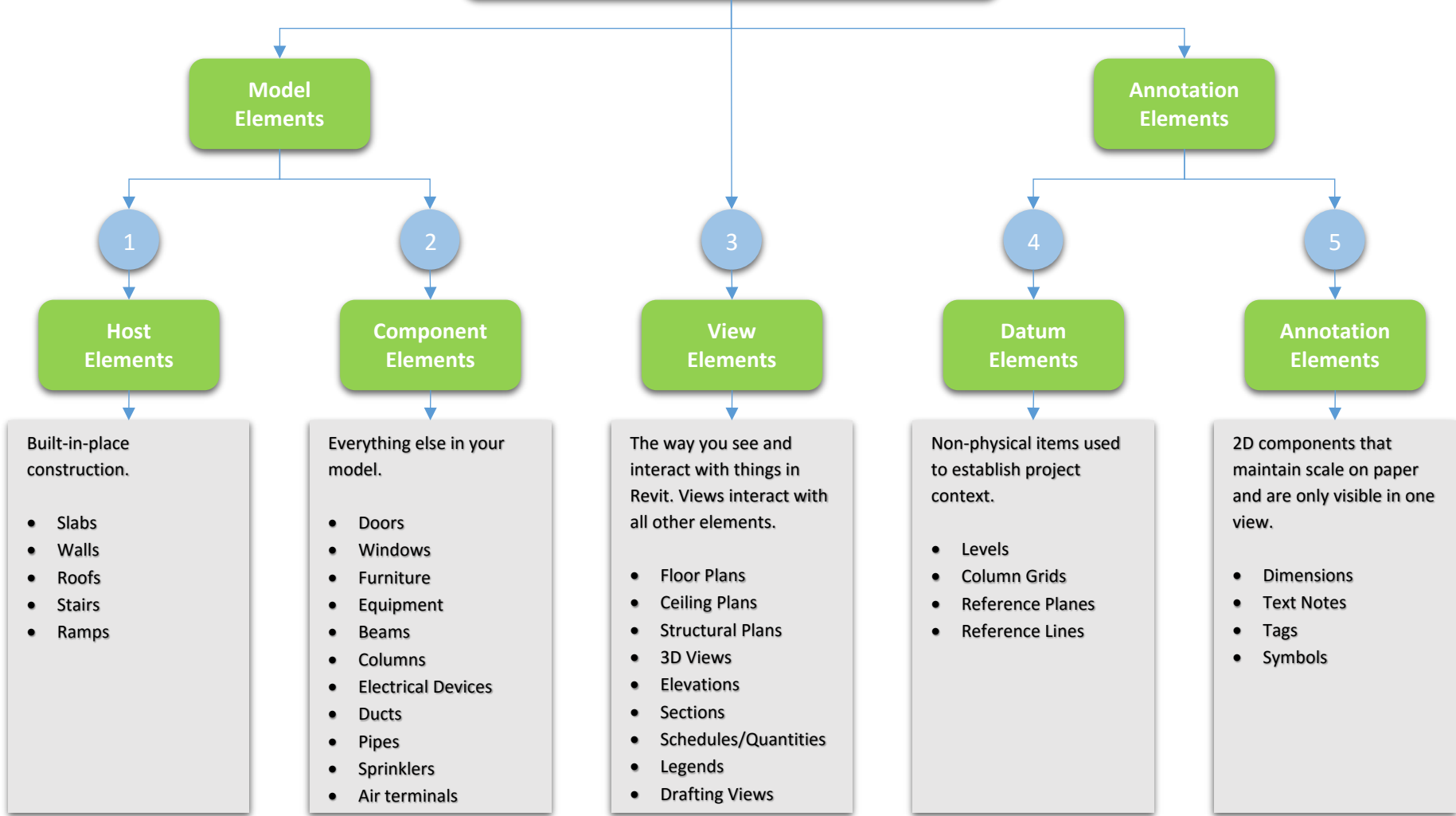


REVIT ELEMENT ORGANISATION

*There are five types of elements.
Each represents something fundamental to your project.*



Revit uses a mechanism called “Family” to manage information related to elements. There are System Families stored within a project .RVT files, and Component Families stored externally on separate Revit Family .RFA files.

Examples of a Family Tree

Element	Family	Type	Instance
Wall	Basic Wall (System Family)	Exterior – Brick on CMU	Actual user drawn wall in project
Door	Doors_ExtDbf_Flush (Component Family)	1810x2110mm	Actual user drawn door in project
